As per rule 10(4) of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Civil Servants (Appointment, Promotion & Transfer) Rules, 1989, the District & Sessions Judge as Competent Authority is pleased to order appointment of the following candidate as **Junior Clerk** in **BPS-11**, on temporary basis, against the vacant post, with effect from the date of his assumption of charge of the post, subject to medical fitness and verification of his antecedents, educational and other testimonials:-


2. His appointment to the service shall be subject to the following terms & conditions:-

- He will be governed by the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Civil Servants Act, 1973 & Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Government Servant (Appointment, Promotion & Transfer) Rules, 1989.
- He will be allowed the minimum pay of BPS-11 plus other allowances as admissible under the rules.
- He shall be governed by such rules & instructions relating to leave, T.A & Medical Attendance as may be prescribed from time to time.
- He shall be on probation initially for a period of one year extendable up to two years.
- He will be eligible for continuance and eventual confirmation in the post on satisfactory completion of their probationary period, subject to availability of permanent posts and the completion of prescribed training, if any.
- His services shall be liable to be dispensed with at any time without notice and assigning any reason before the expiry of the period of his probation/extended period of probation, if, his work or conduct during this period is not found satisfactory. In the event of termination from service, fourteen days notice or in lieu thereof fourteen days pay will be paid to the government. In case of resignation, he will give one month notice to the Competent Authority or in lieu thereof one month pay shall be forfeited to the Government. The resignation shall, however, be subject to the acceptance by the Competent Authority.

- He will be governed by the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Government Servants (Efficiency & Discipline) Rules, 2011 and the NWFP, Government Servants Conduct Rules, 1987 and any other instructions which may be issued by the Competent Authority from time to time.

3. If the above terms & conditions of appointment are acceptable to him, he should report for duty to the undersigned immediately. The offer of appointment shall be deemed to have been cancelled if he fails to report for duty to the undersigned within one month from the date of issue of this order.

4. He shall join duty at his own expenses.
